MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTHWEST PUBLIC POWER AGENCY, INC.

March 20, 2023

A meeting of the Board of Directors of the Southwest Public Power Agency, Inc. ("SPPA") was held on March 20, 2023, at the offices of Clark Hill, located at 3200 North Central Avenue, Suite 1600, Phoenix, Arizona 85012.

The meeting was called to order at 9:11 a.m. President Robbins chaired the meeting while Ms. Torpey acted as secretary.

ROLL CALL

Ms. Torpey called roll of the Members to ensure there was a quorum present. Quorum being established, the business of the meeting proceeded.

Mr. McRae presented the Consent Agenda for the Board's review and possible approval. All items listed on the Consent Agenda may be enacted by a single motion unless a Board Member requests otherwise. There were no approval items from the SPPA Pool Management Committee included in the Consent Agenda.

Ms. Sweeney requested that the Minutes of the March 13, 2023 Executive Session be removed from the Consent Agenda.

Upon discussion, Mr. Steiger moved to approve the contents of the Consent Agenda as presented, with the exception of the Minutes of the March 13, 2023 Executive Session. Mr. Fickett seconded the motion. Upon the taking of a voice vote, the motion was unanimously carried.

ITEM(S) REMOVED FROM CONSENT AGENDA (POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM)

Ms. Sweeney indicated she would confer with staff at a later time regarding possible changes to the March 13, 2023 Executive Session Minutes.

FINANCIAL UPDATE AND TREASURER'S REPORT, INCLUDING DISBURSEMENTS (POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM)

A series of financial reports were presented for the Board's review, including copies of SPPA's balance sheet and profit and loss statement, as well as recent disbursements. Ms. Torpey noted that January's preliminary figures reflected a payment from Enel X, as well as the initial payment reserve amounts made by those Members participating in the index swap endeavor.

Upon discussion, Mr. Downing moved to approve and ratify the financial reports and disbursements as presented, subject to audit. Mr. Yerges seconded the motion. Upon the taking of a voice vote, the motion was unanimously carried.

UPDATE ON EFFORTS TO RENEGOTIATE MESQUITE POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT ENERGY PRICING MECHANISM AND ANY ASSOCIATED TERMS AND CONDITIONS (POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM), INCLUDING EXECUTIVE SESSION PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (3) FOR DISCUSSION OR CONSULTATION FOR LEGAL ADVICE WITH THE ATTORNEY OR ATTORNEYS OF SPPA

Mr. McRae reported that no significant progress had been made in the negotiations on the Mesquite Power Purchase Agreement. In anticipation of short-term resource needs, staff were working towards interim solutions in hopes of limiting the impacts of pricing volatility over the next few months. Additional adjustments to various SPPA policies and procedures may also be necessary to allow for additional flexibility in procuring these resources. No formal action was required at this time and none was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ENGAGEMENT OF BOND COUNSEL (POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM)

Mr. McRae discussed the draft letter agreement from Zach Sakas at Greenberg Traurig, proposing to serve as special public finance counsel for SPPA. Discussion ensued as to the scope of services to be rendered.

Following discussion, Mr. Downing moved to approve execution of the letter agreement from Greenberg Traurig. Mr. Steiger seconded the motion. Upon the taking of a voice vote, the motion was unanimously carried.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ENGAGEMENT OF IT/IT SECURITY CONSULTANT (POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM)

Mr. McRae indicated no report was necessary at this time. No action was taken on the item at this time.
